

Monitoring Native Forest Land in Argentina – 2002 Updating

Loss of Native Forests and Annual Deforestation Rate – Period 1998-2002

Province of Salta

The province of Salta report shows native forest areas in 1998 and in 2002 while revealing land cover changes produced by deforestation, fragmentation, regeneration, recuperation or degradation processes. Furthermore, deforested areas are published for provincial departments into consideration.

Loss of forest land in this province is 194,389 hectares (thereof 152,800 and 41,589 hectares for the Parque Chaqueño and the Selva Tucumano Boliviana respectively) with an annual deforestation rate of –0,69% for the period considered (-0,81% in the Parque Chaqueño and –0,45% in the Selva Tucumano Boliviana).
