

Monitoring Native Forest Land in Argentina – 2002 Updating

Loss of Native Forests and Annual Deforestation Rate – Period 1998–2002

Province of Tucumán

The province of Tucumán report shows native forest areas in 1998 and 2002 while revealing land cover changes produced by deforestation, fragmentation, regeneration, recuperation or degradation processes. Furthermore, deforested areas are published for provincial departments into consideration.

Loss of forest land in this province is 22,171 hectares (thereof 20,865 and 1,306 hectares for the Parque Chaqueño and the Selva Tucumano Boliviana respectively) with an annual deforestation rate of –0,68% for the period considered (-1,97% in the Parque Chaqueño and –0,06% in the Selva Tucumano Boliviana).
